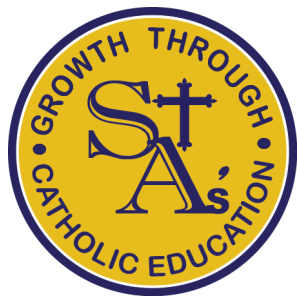

* MEDICATIONS
