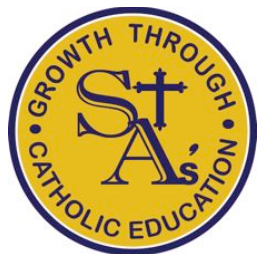

Health Note

PLEASE DO NOT SEND YOUR CHILD TO SCHOOL IF:

- ✓ Your child has had a fever of 100°F or higher within the past 24 hours. Children should be free of fever for a continuous 24 hours before returning to school. Temperatures often spike in the late afternoon/evening hours.
- ✓ You know or suspect that your child has a fever or is ill -- delay sending to school until you have had enough time to observe his/her behavior and feel certain that he/she is well enough to be in school.
- ✓ Your child has been diagnosed with a contagious condition or illness and has not yet received medication for a minimum of 24 hours, or until your doctor tells you your child is no longer contagious.
- ✓ Your child has received medication for an illness for the required 24 hours, but still has a fever.
- ✓ Your child has vomited the night before or in the morning before school.
- ✓ Your child has diarrhea, stomach pain or cramping.

Children who come to school sick are not productive learners and are often miserable all day. More importantly, they can spread the illness to classmates and teachers.

The best way to prevent any infectious disease is to practice good hygiene. Wash your hands frequently using soap and warm water. If you cannot wash your hands, you can use alcohol-based hand sanitizer. A void contact with blood and body fluids of any person, particularly someone who is sick. If you do come into contact with blood or body fluids, wash your hands as soon as possible. Promptly dean items that come into contact with blood or body fluids.
