Students from St. Anthony School participated in the Private Schools Interscholastic Association (PSIA) Academic Meet for District 5A with great success. This competition was held at the Christ the King Cathedral School in Lubbock on Saturday, February 28. A total of 8 schools, along with some home-schooled students, were entered in this event. St. Anthony was one of the smallest schools participating, and we had two students who qualified as alternates for the state competition.

Twenty-three students were entered in 10 events and came away with 2 thirds, 3 fourths, 4 fifths, and 2 sixths. Two students who placed third in their event and serve as alternates may have the opportunity to move forward to the state competition on May 2 in Dallas, Texas, if either first or second place winners are not able to compete: Johan Grotegut and Summer Musick in Storytelling.
