Annual Seder Meal

Our school children (kindergarten through sixth grade), faculty, staff, and invited guests will celebrate our annual Seder Meal on Holy Thursday. We will come together dressed in our "Sunday Best" (no jeans, please) as we celebrate a way to connect more closely to our Savior and His experience prior to His death and resurrection.

The Seder is the meal celebrated at Passover that follows a specific order that retells the story of Moses and the freeing of the Israelites from slavery in Egypt under the pharaoh. The reason we celebrate this meal is because it is the actual meal that our Messiah, Jesus celebrated during the week of His passion, just before he died on the cross and rose again on Easter morning! Jesus gave us the sacrament of Holy Communion *while* he was celebrating the Passover Seder. When we partake in the Seder, we reenact the Last Supper that our Lord had on this earth with His disciples.

One of the greatest experiences that we receive in celebrating the Passover Seder is that we can experience first-hand the Jewish roots of our faith. Our school children anticipate our Seder Meal with much enthusiasm and excitement!

Volunteer School Nurse Needed

A registered nurse or a licensed vocational nurse who volunteers for the school to act in the capacity of the school nurse is subject to the Nurse Practice Act of the Board of Nurse Examiners, State of Texas, and may perform nursing functions only under the supervision and standing orders of a licensed physician and only with a current Texas license.

A registered nurse or licensed vocational nurse, properly trained and certified in screening procedures and emergency response, may perform screenings, emergency response procedures, immunization surveillance and other non-nursing procedures without physician supervision. The Texas Board of Nurse Examiners performs verification of licensure.

It's that time of year when we need to think about pre-registering our children for St. Anthony Catholic School. To hold a spot for your child(ren) for the 2015-2016 school year, you may pre-register beginning April 1st.

Registration forms will be emailed and available online. Please return as soon as possible along with Enrollment Fees. If the entire amount of Enrollment Fee is paid in full by May 16th, a 10% discount will be given.
