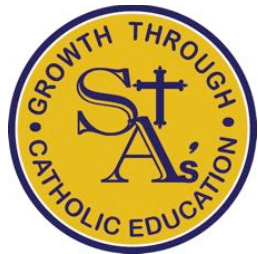

Office Business

Please note: All tuition fees and accounts should be at a zero balance by Friday, May 17, 2013. Please refer to page 3 of the Handbook, which reads as follows: The family accounts must be at a zero balance (current) at the following dates during the school year:

- ❖ Two weeks from the last day of school: Friday, May 15, 2015

Any exceptions to these guidelines will be handled with a meeting between the parents and members of the school board. If you are unable to bring your account current, you will need to make an agreement with the board or your children may be subject to immediate dismissal from the school.

* If you have extenuating circumstances affecting the payment of tuition, you **MUST** communicate these to the office.

School Pre-Registration

It's that time of year when we need to think about pre-registering our children for St. Anthony Catholic School. Registration forms are available online. Please return as soon as possible along with Enrollment Fees. If the entire amount of Enrollment Fee is paid in full by May 16th, a 10% discount will be given.

We are receiving enrollment forms, but no enrollment fees. Please note: **\$100 enrollment fee is due at time of enrollment, with the remaining balance of \$100 due by August 1, 2015.**

Your student(s) is NOT considered enrolled unless at least \$100 of the enrollment fee is paid. We ask that you please assist us in this matter. Blessings!
