ACCREDITATION

St. Anthony Catholic School is an accredited Elementary School recognized by Texas Catholic Conference and the Texas Education Agency.

LUNCH

A hot lunch is served daily. The cost of a student lunch tray is included in your tuition.

TUITION ASSISTANCE

Diocesan Tuition Assistance is available to eligible families who qualify through FACTS Grant & Aid. Deadline for Diocesan Tuition Assistance is May 15th.

TECHNOLOGY

Fiber-optic networked classrooms with a 20-unit iMac computer lab and filtered full internet accessibility; scanners; digital cameras; LCD projection devices, document cameras, and a full-time school technology coordinator. Classroom integration of iMacs and iPads in addition to weekly computer lab instruction for grades Kindergarten – 6th.

RELIGIOUS LIFE

Includes daily religion class, weekly Mass, Daily Morning Prayer, First Reconciliation, First Holy Communion, Liturgical Ministries, Good Shepherd (4k & 5k), adoration, Divine Mercy Chaplet, Rosary; various community service projects.

ANNUAL EVENTS

Catholic Schools Week activities, Christmas Program, Book Fair, Science Fair, Seder Meal, Spelling Bee, Track Meet, School Picnic, and Summer Academy

TEACHERS

All classroom teachers are highly qualified and fully certified with a combined average of 18 years teaching experience.

CALENDAR

Calendar closely follows the HISD calendar and Diocesan calendar. School hours are 8:00am – 3:30pm for Kindergarten – 6th Grade and 8:00am – 12:30pm for 4K/Pre-Kindergarten.

CURRENT ENROLLMENT

Current enrollment is approximately 120 students in Pre-Kindergarten through 6th Grade.

PARENTS

Parents are a HUGE part of St. Anthony School. Parent Teacher Organization (PTO), Room Parents, Advisory Board, Pastoral Council, Finance Council, Catholic Life Insurance, Fundraisers, classroom aides, substitutes, volunteer coaches, Fall and Spring Parent Teacher Conferences.

DRESS CODE

St. Anthony School's dress code consists of the navy and khaki dress uniform on Monday, Wednesday, Thursday, and Friday. Tuesday is designated as our "Spirit Tee" Tuesday. The dress code provides a cohesive standard that our entire community can be proud to wear and recognize.

ACADEMIC ACHIEVEMENT

Historically students who attend St. Anthony's maintain our high academic reputation upon their 6th grade graduation. A high percentage is in the top 10-15% of their high school graduating class.

TUITION

Tuition is kept affordable. A multi-student discount is given to parents of two or more children enrolled at St. Anthony's. The discount increases with each additional child.

CURRICULUM

Religion, Reading, English/Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, Library, Art, Computer Technology, Music, Health/Physical Education, Swimming, 6th Grade Band.

EXTENDED DAY

Located in the primary building, Extended Day provides after school care for working parents of 4K-6th grade students. Provides time for homework completion, as well as recreational and creative activities in a safe and comfortable environment until 5:15pm each workday.

LIBRARY

Our library contains over 10,000 books, and each student participates in the Accelerated Reading program. All classes have a library "enrichment" period each week.
